

Car Parking Rules

- Parking at St James Terrace is a privilege of full club membership on a fair usage basis.
- Parking is intended for active club members who are on club business, or going sailing or to their boat, or making short term (<3hrs) stays while in the village.
- Parking for extended periods on a daily basis is not permitted and is an over use of the parking privilege, (e.g. for purposes of commuting to city, or attending workplace). Such incidents of abuse should be reported to the committee.
- MYC has an annual contract for parking enforcement as follows:
 - Call out service – where authorised people from MYC can call to get a vehicle clamped.
 - Patrols – where clamper will call randomly to the site and clamp vehicles parked illegally.
- Current Parking Tags must be displayed clearly on the windscreen.
- Parking Patrol enforcement and clamping is in operation daily, including weekends.
- Once clamped the club has no means of overruling or releasing the clamp.
- The following are the time frames we have advised Parking Patrol not to visit and clamp.
 - No clamping after 7pm on Monday-Friday or after 3pm on Weekends, to facilitate visitors and guests to visit Club Premises and social events.
 - No clamping during drop off or collection of children for creche, (10mins “grace” period).
- For safety we request that you park by reversing into marked parking spaces.
- Occasionally on busy club events additional cars may park in centre area, blocking other club members, who are assumed to be at the club event. Please be mindful of this if not attending a club event.
- Occasionally parking spaces will be taken up with club activities such as the Marquee, storage of dinghies, hosting a BBQ. We ask members to cooperate with such events by removing their car accordingly, which will be communicated to members via newsletter and group Whatsapp.
